About Dr. Nanduri: Dr. Nanduri Prabhakar, Ph.D., D.Sc. is the Harold H. Hines Jr. Professor and Director of the Institute for Integrative Physiology at the University of Chicago in Chicago, Illinois. Dr. Prabhakar is a leading authority on O₂ sensing mechanisms and physiological consequences of hypoxia. His laboratory has identified several novel signaling pathways and molecular mechanisms underlying the cardio-respiratory morbidities associated with chronic intermittent hypoxia. Dr. Prabhakar spent 22 years at Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio, where he held many positions, including Professor and Vice Chairman of Department of Physiology and Biophysics. He serves as the Deputy Chairman of the Editorial Board for the Journal of Experimental Physiology. Dr. Prabhakar is a Member of numerous societies. He received his D. Sc. in Biology from Ruhr-University, Germany.
